ARTISTS' RESIDENCIES

LA BOX 2021-2022

THE RESIDENCY

Each year since 1991 the École nationale supérieure d'art (National School of Art/ENSA) in Bourges, has been providing residencies for young artists, with the financial backing of the Regional Cultural Affairs Office (DRAC), the Centre-Val de Loire Region and Agglomération Community Bourges Plus. These residencies are intended to give young artists from France and abroad the opportunity to carry out a personal artistic project connected with the School, its teaching, its students and other external partners.

The winning candidates are chosen by a jury comprising one representative each from the Regional Cultural Affairs office, the Centre-Val de Loire Region and the Centre Region Contemporary Art Collection, together with the School's director, three members of the teaching staff, the coordinator of La Box, and an art world personality.

FINANCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The successful candidate will be awarded a three-month residency during the academic year at a period to be decided on.

He or she will receive a grant of 3,000 euros, a production budget not exceeding 2,000 euros and a possible publishing budget not exceeding 2,000 euros.

PROCEDURE

Once the successful applicant has been chosen, the research project and its budgetary requirements are submitted to La Box director Véronique Fréjabue a month before the beginning of the residency. When the resident artist arrives a validation meeting is held and a contract is signed between him/her and the School.

The resident artist undertakes to give a talk about his/her work at the beginning of the stay and to set up a workshop project with the students.

The artist will work closely with the teaching team and in particular with the full-time staff of La Box: Véronique Fréjabue (director of La Box), Jessie Morin (registrar) and Edwige Bélaïr (assistant).

The resident artist is provided with accommodation space of 100 square metres within the art School, comprising a studio, kitchenette, bedroom and mezzanine bathroom.

THE APPLICATION

The application might be written either in English or in French and must include the following:

- a completed application form
- a CV
- an outline of the artist's general approach (no more than 600 words)
- an outline of the planned residency project (no more than 600 words)
- 20 captioned visuals
- 2 articles or texts about the applicant's work (written by the artist or a third party)

The age limit for La Box residencies is 35.
